Scope: Fabrication of 4-legged column with ring pontoon configuration. Delivered in 2008.

Highlights:

Total structural weight of near to 13,000 tons.

Loaded-out directly from DM's yard side quay by skidding method onto transport barge

• Gigantic area hull footprint of 70m(l) x 70m(w) x 50m(h)

Details:

- Located at approximately 230 km southeast of New Orleans, Louisiana with water depth of 1,900 m.
- Production capacity of 45,000 b/d of oil and gas-lift and export capacity of 70 MMSCFD of natural gas.
- Facility owned by SBM Offshore and operated by Murphy Oil. Thunder Hawk FPU is SBM's first lease
 unit in the GOM, currently being leased to Noble Energy.
